

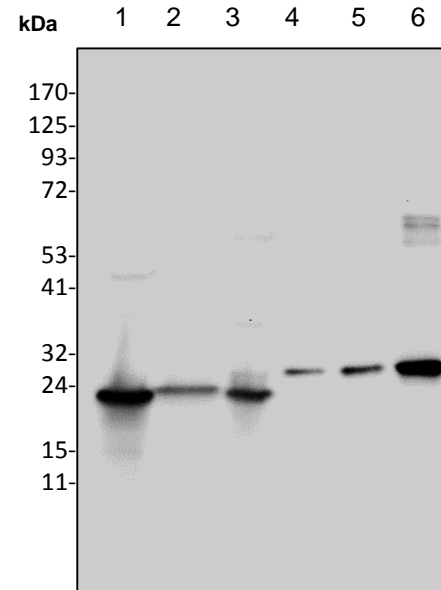

DESCRIPTION: Glutathione S-transferase P is an enzyme in human encoded by the GSTP1 gene. Glutathione S-transferases (GSTs) are a family of enzymes that play an important role in detoxification by catalyzing the conjugation of many hydrophobic and electrophilic compounds with reduced glutathione. Based on their biochemical, immunologic, and structural properties, the soluble GSTs are categorized into 4 main classes: alpha, mu, pi, and theta. The glutathione S-transferase pi gene (GSTP1) is a polymorphic gene encoding active, functionally different GSTP1 variant proteins that are thought to function in xenobiotic metabolism and play a role in susceptibility to cancer, and other diseases.

APPLICATION: Western blot: 1-4 µg/ml

Western Blot analysis of anti-GSTP1 antibody with Jurkat cells (1), 3T3 cells (2) and rat kidney lysate (3). GSTP1 (arrow) was detected using the purified antibody. Antibody sensitivity is also tested by 2 ng (4), 10 ng (5), 100 ng (6) human GSTP1 (his-tagged) recombinant protein.
