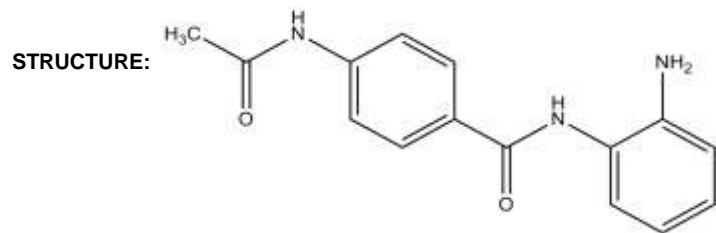

DESCRIPTION: Cell-permeable. A histone deacetylase (HDAC) inhibitor (K_i values are 0.41, 0.75, >100 and >100 μM for HDAC1, HDAC3, HDAC6 and HDAC8 respectively). Displays significant antitumor activity *in vitro* and *in vivo* against a broad spectrum of murine and human tumor models.
