

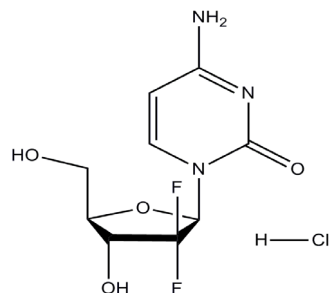
Gemcitabine Hydrochloride

DESCRIPTION: A nucleoside analog of deoxycytidine used in chemotherapy to treat various types of cancer. Gemcitabine is converted intracellularly to the active metabolites difluorodeoxycytidine di- and triphosphate (dFdCDP, dFdCTP). dFdCDP inhibits ribonucleotide reductase, thereby decreasing the deoxynucleotide pool available for DNA synthesis; dFdCTP is incorporated into DNA, resulting in DNA strand termination and apoptosis. Gemcitabine hydrochloride is a deoxycytidine analog that inhibits DNA synthesis and repair. emcitabine, inhibit novel coronavirus (SARS-CoV-2) in cell culture

HANDLING: Do not take internally. Wear gloves and mask when handling the product! Avoid contact by all modes of exposure.
