

DESCRIPTION: Ketoconazole is a broad-spectrum triazole antifungal agent. It inhibits the fungal cytochrome P450

(CYP) isoform CYP51, also known as lanosterol 14 α -demethylase, which arrests ergosterol biosynthesis at the fungal membrane. Ketoconazole also inhibits human CYP3A4 (IC50 = 0.54 μ M). Formulations containing ketoconazole have been used in the treatment of fungal infections.

STORAGE TEMPERATURE: -20°C. Protect from light

HANDLING: Do not take internally. Wear gloves and mask when handling the product! Avoid contact by all modes of

exposure.
